### Preparing to Do Our Work

The meeting was opened at 7:03pm by Becky McDonough and Board members checked in; Becky McDonough and Rev Lillie shared reading our agreements. Susan Mintz led us in prayer.

Marilyn Kane established a Quorum: 6/7 members present were: Brock, Clayton, Frye, Kane, McDonough, F. Mintz Absent: LaChapelle Guests: S. Mintz, B. Alberti, D. Berger, S. Serrao

### Our Role as a Working Board

Receive and Approve Reports for August 17,2021 Board Meeting, Financial Reports for August 2021, and the Pastor's Report for August, 2021. Motion by Clayton, second by F. Mintz, and approved unanimously.

Doug Berger reviewed the Treasurer's Report from the Finance Team. We have been holding our own for the budget but August has been a rough month. We have now exhausted our resources such as Bridge the Gap and SeedPlanters. We are currently \$22,000 under budget which has been reduced to \$10,846 via love offerings. Rev. Lillie noted we have lost 12 Congregants this year of which 8 were regular givers. Our members continue to give what they pledged. We have the last of our \$25,000 CDs maturing soon for the \$25K plus approximately \$1600 in interest. After lengthy discussion, we narrowed it down to 2 viable choices: 1) roll it over for the next 2-year period at negligible interest about 0.75% or 2) cash it in and designate half to our NYL annuity and half into our Operations budget. However, we have a policy F603 that we have to pay back borrowing from our contingency budget which will need to be amended and then suspended in order to do this. The following 3 motions were made: 1) Jesse Clayton made a motion to cash out the CD and deposit \$12, 500 into NYL Annuity and the rest into operations, seconded by Becky McDonough, vote was unanimous; 2) Jesse Clayton made a motion to revise Section F603 to allow changes to temporarily suspend a policy as a result of extenuating circumstances seconded by Deb Frye, vote was unanimous; 3) Jesse Clayton made a motion to suspend policy Section E 510 Section V to allow designated contingency funds to be used for Operations for 24 months and review it at our Oct 2023 Board Meeting, seconded by Becky McDonough, vote was unanimous.

Doug Berger also presented the draft Budget for 2022 which showed the deficit in income vs expenses. See above report on contingency funds which deals with this issue. There are modest increases for staff and a line for a pianist. It is a work in progress and a rebuilding year. This will be revised and prepared for Congregational Meetings in October.

### Our Role as a Strategic Body

Rev Lillie reviewed attendance at worship services which averages 55 at our onsite and 45 at our online services. Visitors are coming back onsite, several under 65. She is in the process of developing a Membership Class online. Rev. Lillie presented an amendment to the Bylaws Article IV, Section A which is Criteria for

Membership to allow for Virtual Membership. Please see attached proposal for specific wording. Becky McDonough made motion to approve the amendment to Bylaw's Article IV, Section A, seconded by Jesse Clayton, vote was unanimous. This will presented at Board Forum on Oct. 24 for information and then will be forwarded to the Congregation for action at the Congregational Meeting on Nov 7<sup>th</sup>.

### Our Role as a Governance Body

Reviewed the policy and procedures for onsite services for dealing with Covid 19 Pandemic which are working well. Local statistics indicate we should continue with them.

Board Forum. Reminder to attend Board Forum on Oct 24<sup>th</sup>, Budget Forum on Oct 31<sup>st</sup>, and Congregational Meeting on Nov. 7<sup>th</sup>.
