



### **Urgent Announcement!**

#### Dear Ones:

As much as no pastor ever wants to do this, I am writing to inform you that by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors, we are suspending our Worship Services and Programming for the next two weeks. I have been thinking about this for several days and have prayed over it diligently, and it seems that this is the best course for us to take so that we are certain we have taken the utmost care of our congregation.

After listening to the experts on the news, reading every article we can find and consulting trusted advisers, we believe that there are two major reasons to suspend our church services and activities:

- 1. Our congregation is made up of a large percentage of people who have the top 2 elements of greatest susceptibility:
  - They are over 60 years old
  - They have underlying health issues
- 2. Though there seems to be no significant spread in our area, there is also an issue of there being very little testing done and very few testing kits available. This means that without adequate testing, we have no idea who may be carrying the virus. We do not want to look back and wish we had done this before one of our own was infected!

We have put together a plan for this two-week period and want to outline it here for you.

# Worship

There will be No Worship Services on March 15th and 22nd.
